



2026 ADGA National Show Camping FAQ

How do I reserve a spot for my RV?

Please use the Eastern States Exposition (ESE) online reservation form here: <https://buff.ly/WbK09Ps>. You will be provided with a QR code to be scanned at check-in, where you will receive a hang tag to display in your vehicle.

How many camping site reservations will be sold?

There are currently 250 spots available to reserve. Once 250 have been reserved, the facility will let ADGA know whether any more are available.

What does "first-come, first-served" mean?

If you have a pre-reserved spot, you are guaranteed a camping spot. However, individual site locations are determined as exhibitors arrive. The ESE will direct each arrival and determine how best to use the available spaces. Most campers will be sited in the Mallery parking lot, on blacktop, and parked very tightly together. There are additional spots, on grass and with more space, between the horse barns; there are also spots available on a mix of gravel and grass near the lagoon. Please see the facility map.

Is there a maximum size for RVs?

35' is the longest RV that can be accommodated. Large RVs may need to be sited in further-out lots, depending on how many show up.

How many of those pre-reserved spots have full electric/sewer hookups?

All 250 pre-reserved spots are either full or shared hook-ups. Most have 50A service, and some have 30A service (plus sewer) Once those have been filled, there may be additional spots available dry camping in Lot 9.

Can I sleep in my livestock trailer?

The short answer is yes. ***Sleeping in a trailer without living quarters is at your own risk.*** If you plan to use your trailer for camping, you will need to register as a camper and move it to the designated camping space.

Is tent camping allowed?

Yes. There is no fee for tent camping. Please use the provided form to reserve space. Tent campers will need to sign a hold harmless agreement. For safety and security, tents must be in designated areas. Tent Camping is not allowed in the barns.

Are rental companies or exhibitors allowed to deliver and set up on Friday, June 26?

Yes. There is a form that must be filled out, which the venue will release soon. Please note that only the RV may be set up on Friday. Exhibitors may not stay overnight in the RV until they have come through the Vet Check on Saturday. Absolutely no animals allowed on site prior to Vet Check. (Exceptions: ADGA Staff, National Show/Sales Committee, approved volunteers who need to be present for Vet Check)

If RV deliveries arrive on Saturday, will there be a separate line/entrance for them, so they do not have to wait in the vet check line?

Yes, RV company drop-offs do not need to go through Vet Check.
